

Exploring The Region

While it's easy to talk about it in just two words, the "Hudson Valley" is a large place. Big Gay Hudson Valley has been a part of the thriving queer community here since 2008, focusing on the six Mid-Hudson counties that run the length of the mighty Hudson

Driving is the most flexible way to explore, traversing the region with the New York State Thruway on the west side of the river or the Taconic State Parkway on the east. Don't miss the stunning views from the several bridges that cross the Hudson River, many of which also have pedestrian and/or bike lanes on them. Rideshare services like Uber or Lyft are also available.

Commuter trains originating out of New York City's Grand Central and Penn Stations provide access to walkable river communities like Cold Spring, Beacon, Poughkeepsie, and Hudson as well as central Dutchess county. The Trailways Bus departs from New York City's Port Authority Terminal and makes stops on the west side of the river in the Village of New Paltz, Town of Rosendale and City of Kingston.

Big Gay Hudson Valley's online business directory includes a wide array of LGBTQ+ owned and allied businesses organized by category, city and county. Check out BigGayHudsonValley. com/LocalGuides to plan your trip, book lodging and find a new favorite shop, restaurant or attraction.

Discover Dutchess County

Dutchess County features four distinct destinations in one and each region celebrates its own unique personality - from sophisticated to spirited, reinvented to inspired. Across the County visitors are invited to experience a plethora of historical sites, scenic outdoor locations, artistic and cultural attractions, shops, restaurants, tasting rooms, farms and more.

The energy of the Queen City of Poughkeepsie is balanced by the idyllic, rural ambiance of towns like Lagrange and Union Vale. Just north of the Queen City you'll find Hyde Park - home to the Franklin Delano Roosevelt Home, Presidential Library and Museum - Northern Dutchess, and the Villages Rhinebeck and Red Hook.

Eastern Dutchess is defined by the Harlem Valley, dappled with the towns of Amenia, Dover, Pawling and Pine Plains and the villages of Millerton and Millbrook – each with their own personality and queer communities

Southern Dutchess is home to Beekman and Poughquag and the towns of Wappingers Falls, Fishkill and the City of Beacon, where you can enjoy an afternoon of shopping, visits to great art galleries and museums, or a night out in their restaurants and bars.

In recent years we've seen many LGBTQ+ organizations and pride events pop up here, Poughkeepsie is home to the Dutchess Pride Foundation organizer of Poughkeepsie's annual Pride Parade - while many other small pride celebrations are hosted in Red Hook, Stanford, Millbrook and more.
